



LOCAL RULES

You are on an operational military airbase. Please do not leave the golf course boundaries.

In case of any problem, please call the Clubhouse at +32 244 26423 or the guardhouse at +32 244 26356

For emergency assistance, contact 112 then the security center +32 244 26535

Out of bounds :

They are delimited by:

- White stakes,
- The fences delimiting the course (fence wires), the roads and the asphalt or paved sidewalks, with the exception of the paths that cross holes 1/10 and 4/13

Abnormal course conditions (Rule 16 applies)

Ground under repair (GUR)

- Areas surrounded by a circle of white paint and/or marked with blue stakes.

Immovable obstructions

- Trees with stakes
- The concrete border that runs through the inside of the bunker in front of the green of hole 5/14
- Electric fences against wild boars

Penalty zones (Rule 17 applies)

No-Play Zones

- Demarcated by red or blue stakes with green tops.

Robotic lawnmowers

- **Stopped:** Immovable obstructions
- **In motion:** External influences
- **Never touch or move a robot, and do not play in its direction if you risk hitting it.**

Provisional ball

If there is doubt as to whether or not a ball has been lost in the penalty areas located at the edge of the fairways and delimited by red or red and green stakes, the player may play a provisional ball in accordance with Rule 18.3 as amended:

- If the original ball is found outside the penalty area, the player must continue playing with it.
- If the original ball is found in the penalty area within the 3-minute time limit, the player may either play it as it lies or continue to play the provisional ball.
- If the original ball is, in all likelihood, in an area delimited by red and green stakes (no play), the player must continue to play the provisional ball.
- If the original ball is not found within the 3 minutes allowed, the provisional ball becomes the ball in play.

Penalty for non-compliance with this local rule: General Penalty

Vigilance

At the start of hole 6/15, please ring the bell before playing as soon as the team ahead of you is out of range.

Announce your presence if you are approaching or on the green of holes 7/16.

Starting from the 5/14 hill, make sure the ring road is clear and that no vehicles are approaching the starting area.

Priority

Players on holes 7/16 have priority over those on holes 6/15. Use common sense.
and courtesy. Be vigilant.
